The meeting started with the welcome address by Dr.D.Suganya Devi, Director, Department of MCA

The Chairperson Mrs.R.Gunavathi introduced the experts to the forum. The detailed discussions were held on the following agenda:

1. Changes for 2012-2015 batch
2. Syllabus formation for 2013 batch as per the communication from AICTE.

The following suggestions were given by the BOS members whom are to be incorporated in the syllabus for 2012-2015 batch

1. The Domain based electives, Quantitative Techniques and Visual Programming has been moved to the III semester. Software Engineering, Specialization elective I (Software Testing) and Computer Networks have been moved from III semester to IV semester. Specialization elective II (Java Technologies) has been moved from III semester to IV semester.
2. In Specialization elective II (Java Technologies), the course 'J2EE' has been renamed as 'J2EE and J2ME' and 2 units of J2EE and 3 units of J2ME have to be incorporated in the syllabus.
3. In semester IV, the optional elective I, Digital Image Processing has been moved to optional elective II and the optional elective .NET technologies has been moved to optional elective I.
4. In semester VI, the course "Emerging trends in IT" has been changed to 'Advanced Computing Techniques'. The syllabus for the course is subject to change (if needs) as per the current industry needs.



  
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**Resolution:**

The Board reviewed the course structure and suggested introduction of new courses, modification in the existing syllabus as detailed above and it is resolved that the new syllabus and scheme of Examination for MCA be approved and the same be implemented for the students admitted in 2013 – 14 and onwards (Schemes & syllabus enclosed in annexure 1)

Also the following suggestions were given by the BOS members, which are to be incorporated in the syllabus for the forthcoming 2013-2016 batch

1. In semester II, the V unit of the course 'Operating Systems' can be incorporated with the fundamental concepts of cloud computing. For the course "Communication for Executives", reference books need to be added.
2. In semester III, the course 'Computer Networks' is changed as 'Computer Communication and Networks'. The course 'Numerical Algorithm and Statistics' need to be modified.
3. In Semester IV, The core elective I - Option D "Network Security and Cryptography" some of the topics is incorporated in the "Computer Communication and Networks". So, it needs to be removed. The course 'Management Information System' has been changed to 'Security Management Systems' as same syllabus of the core elective II - Option D – "Information Security and Cyber Crimes". So, it needs to be removed.

**Resolution:**

- It is resolved to make the changes made in the syllabus outlined above for the MCA programme for students admitted in 2012-2013. (Schemes & syllabus enclosed in annexure 2).

3. It is resolved to introduce **"Custom Duty & Goods and Services Tax"** in the syllabus as core paper instead of "Applied Cost Accounting" in IV Semester for the students admitted from 2016-17 & 2017-18 and onwards and the syllabus and the Scheme for the same submitted to the Board was reviewed and approved.

- vii. In Unit – IV “The Workman's Compensation Act, 1923” is to be deleted, “1923” is to be added with “Employee Compensation Act”.
  - viii. In Unit – V “The Trade Union Act, 1926 and latest legislations - Permissible deductions under payment of wages Act 1936.” are to be deleted. The Inter State migrant workmen (Regulation of employment and conditions of Service) Act 1979 - The Sexual Harassment of Women at Workplace (Prevention, Prohibition and redressal) Act 2013 are to be added.
  - ix. In the course “Health Care and Hospital Management” in Unit – I “Meaning of Health, concept and determinants of health” are to be added, “Demographic structure and health implications; and history of implementation; Mass Communication and its impact in healthcare delivery. Determinants of Health: Life style – Socio-economic conditions – Heredity – Environment – Other factors. Introduction to mass spread diseases and factors abating It.” are to be deleted.
  - x. In Unit – III “In-patient, Out Patient, Emergency, and Causality” are to be added, “nursing home / clinic - understanding their roles and interdependence – systems and procedures” are to be deleted.
  - xi. In Unit – IV “Principle of Management, Training and Development for staff” are to be added, “Clinicalspecializations” is to be deleted.
  - xii. In Unit –V “Solid – Waste Management” is to be added, “(introduction to medical equipment and tools) – janitorial services” are to be deleted
- 7) It is resolved to shift the “Ethics and values in Business Management” course from III Semester to IV semester and rename the course as “ Ethics and values in Business”.
- 8) It is resolved to shift the “Project work & viva voce ” from IV Semester to III semester.
- 9) It is resolved to shift the course “Internship / on the job training & viva voce” from IV semester to III semester
- 10) It is resolved to shift the “Strategic Management” course from IV semester to III semester.
- 11) It is decided to rename the course “Global business environment” as “Global Business”.
- 12) It is resolved to study and understand in detail about the practical implementation of Industry Institute Interactive programme and after further deliberations an appropriate decision can be taken in this regard.
- 13) It is resolved to change the system of giving all the elective papers of a particular elective in a single semester to giving the elective papers ( 2 papers each)in two consecutive semesters of final year.

All the value additions prescribed by experts during the course of deliberation are taken in right prospective. All such values will be taken up for consideration in a phased manner.
